RACE PARTICIPANTS: Races will be held in each of the age/rank categories: Tiger Cubs, Wolves, Bears and Webelos (1st & 2nd year Webelos will race as one group). All Cub Scout Packs in the district are encouraged to send their top three winners in each rank (15 youth in total). Substitutions for your top three winners are allowed if one of the top 3 is not available to race.

REGISTRATION SIGN-UP: Registration /FEE form will be available in January. Appropriate registration information and fees will be due by February 6th to register at the Early Bird Fee. The race format will allow for each of the ranks to race at the same time. The **GRAND CHAMPION RACE** will occur approximately 15 minutes after the last age group completes their races. Trophies will be awarded for First through Third Place winners in each category as well as a Grand Trophy for the overall winner.

SPECIAL NOTE:

Registration closes at 10:30. PLEASE DO NOT show up a couple of minutes before with the hope that you will get through Registration, weight in, etc. We need time to get all Pinewood Cars entered into the appropriate computer before the race starts. Please see the Golden Arrow District Pinewood Derby Rules and Regulations ([Official G.A.D. Pinewood Derby Race Rules](#)) to be sure your Cub Scout's cars are built to the run-off specs. Again, only approved BSA equipment, wheels and nails (axles) may be used. Please check rules as it relates to what you can do to the nails and axles and the dimensions and weight of the car. It would be to your advantage to share copies of the rules with your parents and Cub Scouts when they receive their Pinewood Derby Kit.
